**TANTRUM**

<p><b>CHARACTERISTICS</b></p>	<p>Tantrum is made from a stoneware body. The glass has been encapsulated and fused to the clay.</p>
<p><b>INSTALLATION &amp; MAINTENANCE</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- It is very important to use a thin diamond blade to cut Tantrum tiles, not a tile/brick blade.</li> <li>- Use Super Glue on cut line to help hold in glass freed from cut</li> <li>- After installation, surrounding grout will hold glass on cut edges</li> </ul>
<p><b>USAGE</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Suitable for wall use, both interior and exterior applications. According to ASTM tests may be used in areas that experience freeze/thaw conditions.</li> <li>- Suitable for pools, except in freeze-thaw areas</li> </ul>
<p><b>ASTM TEST RESULTS</b> (American Society Testing for Materials)</p>	<p>Tantrum tiles were tested by Tile Council of America with the following results: 1) ASTM Test C650: resistant to common household cleaning chemicals and pool chemicals. Best to avoid strong solution acids. 2) ASTM Test C1026: no visible evidence of freeze-thaw damage</p>
